Under English law, administration lasts for one year unless extended. As you are aware, an administration order was made in respect of the Company by the High Court in London, on 14 January 2009. Following extension applications made by the Joint Administrators, the administration was extended, most recently on 30 November 2020 by order of Mr Justice Snowden (as he then was). The administration is currently due to expire on 13 January 2023.

The application to extend the administration is largely a procedural matter, which the Joint Administrators consider is in the interests of the Company and its creditors. The Joint Administrators have recently sent to creditors a general update on the progress of the administration, and we are pleased to refer you to the most recent progress report dated 11 August 2022 which is available on this website. We don't propose to update you in depth in this notice and further details will be provided in the witness statement that will be made available on this website.

Without an extension of their term of office, the Joint Administrators would be unable to continue to represent the interests of the creditors of the Company in the matters referred to in the most recent progress report. This would lead to further delay, expense and, ultimately, a less favourable resolution for the Company's creditors.

For these reasons, the Joint Administrators intend to submit the application and evidence to apply for an extension of the administration of the Company on 14 November 2022. The hearing of the application may be conducted remotely via Microsoft Teams or other teleconferencing methods. The Joint Administrators will provide further details of the hearing in due course, including the date on which the hearing is listed, details of how to attend the hearing remotely, if that is the format in which it will be held. If you consider that you are affected by this application, then you have the right to attend the hearing and be heard if you chose to do so.
