NOTICE TO CREDITORS REGARDING THE ORDER GRANTING THE JOINT ADMINISTRATORS' THEIR DISCHARGE FROM LIABILITY

On 17 March 2026, the Joint Administrators appeared before the Court in support of an application dated 7 November 2025 for an order that (among other things) the current and former joint administrators of the Company be discharged from liability pursuant to paragraph 98(2)(c) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 ("Schedule B1") with effect from 28 days after the date on which a notice from the Joint Administrators pursuant to paragraph 84(1) of Schedule B1 has been registered by the Registrar of Companies (the "Discharge Application").

Pursuant to an Order dated 17 March 2026, ICC Judge Prentis ordered and directed that the Discharge Application be granted.
